Cinnamon Ornaments

1 cup ground cinnamon 4 tablespoons white glue 3/4 to 1 cup water

Stir together cinnamon, glue, and water. The dough should be as thick as cookie dough. Refrigerate the dough for 2 hours. Sprinkle cinnamon onto the work surface. Spoon chilled dough onto work surface and knead the dough until it is smooth. Sprinkle more cinnamon onto the work surface. With a rolling pin roll the dough to about a 1/4-inch thickness. Cut out shapes with cookie cutters. Poke a hole in each shape with a plastic straw. To dry the shapes lay them on waxed paper at room temperature and turn them over twice a day for four days. To speed up the drying, bake the ornaments on a cookie sheet in a warm oven for 2 hours. When the shapes are dry, add ribbon hangers. Use acrylic paints to decorate the shapes.
